EVENTS – Helps with fundraising, Chicken BBQ, Craft fairs and possible other socials.

FINANCE – Assist the Pastor and is appointed by the Pastor. The committee is the key element for promoting the financial health of parish, assuring accountability.

GARDENERS – Assist in the upkeep of the parish property.

GREETERS – Promotes a sense of welcoming and belonging to all the faithful assembled for worship. You would arrive at Mass about half hour early to welcome those coming. Usually assigned to a Mass.

HOSPITALITY COMMITTEE - The purpose of this committee is to serve in a friendly and welcoming way at various parish social events that come along. Duties include assisting with food and drink service, making new faces feel welcome, and taking the extra step to make people feel special.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS – is a Men's organization who through service- faith, community, family, youth and fellowship make a difference. They serve the parish when needed.

LECTOR – Proclaims the Word of the Lord at Mass. Training is involved and assigned to Masses on Saturday or Sunday or special liturgies.

LITURGY COMMITTEE – Works with the pastor in planning.

MUSIC MINISTRY (ADULT) – Organist, guitarist, or pianist to play for Sundays, Weddings Funerals, special liturgies, or even backup; leaders of song/cantors and parish choir members.

NURSING MINISTRY – Nurses trained and license who collaborate with the pastor to work with the parishioners to bring holistic approach integrating the mind, body, and a variety of activities.

PARISH COUNCIL – Advises the pastor and appointed by the pastor. The main purpose is to discuss, reflect and reach conclusions about pastoral matters.

PRO LIFE – Participates in activities supporting human life.

RICA – Assist on the team with adults who want to join the Catholic Church or complete all their sacraments. Programs begin in the Fall and concludes at the Easter Vigil.

SOCIAL ACTION – Serve those in need in the parish and community. New members welcomed and needed. Many projects always going on.

STEPHEN MINISTRY – Parishioners willing to listen, encourage and help parishioners through difficult times in their lives. Training through the diocese is involved and ALL communications with families is strictly confidential.

TECHNOLOGY – Assist at Mass with running media in the church and hall.

USHERS (Male & Female) – Assigned to a Mass. Responsible for helping to seat parishioners, take up the collection and distribute bulletins.

YOUTH -High School (grades 9-12), Junior High (grades 5-8th). Two or more adults are always present at activities and go through Virtus Training by the diocese and have a background checks done. Core activities include Prayers, discussion, service projects, social events, meditation, fitness and more. Also have annual events for families and children of all ages.
